

Kyudong Kwak Artistic Director

Kyudong Kwak was born in Daegu, Korea. He began his ballet training at an early age at the Universal Ballet Company. He was promoted each year, until he became the youngest principal in the Universal Ballet Company. He performed many in many different countries. Some examples include the eighteen cities of Japan, Twain, Italy, Austria and the United States.

Later, He received additional training at the Kirov Ballet Academy in Washington, D.C. He won a gold medal at the Korean Dance Competition, the Dong –Ah Dance Competition.

He was the first Asian guest dancer at the Kirov Ballet Company in Russia, where he danced the role of Blue Bird in their production of Sleeping Beauty at the Marinsky Theatre.

Kwak danced with the Universal Ballet Company for eight years, and with the Seoul Ballet Theatre for three years, as a principal dancer. His career in Nevada began in 1998 at Nevada Ballet Theatre as a principal dancer. He later advanced to Ballet Master.

He is the Founder of The Las Vegas Ballet Company in 2009 with his wife Yoomi Lee. He choreographed Bach-Three movement, Glory, and Mozart. Kwak's repertoire include principal roles in Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, Coppelia, Midsummer Night Dream, The Nutcracker, Romeo and Juliet, Giselle, Don Quixote, Paquita, Peter Pan, Dracula, George Balanchine's Serenade, Four temperaments, La Sonnambula, Theme and Variation and many others.

Kwak was a former full-time faculty at the Dixie State University dance department.

Yoomi Lee Ballet Mistress

Yoomi Lee was born in Seoul, Korea and graduated from Sun- wha Arts School, majoring in Ballet. She joined the Universal Ballet Company right after she graduated high school. She was promoted to the rank of soloist in Universal Ballet Company. She performed all over the world, namely in Japan, Twain, Italy, Austria, and the United States for eleven years.

She received a scholarship to the summer course at the Kirov Ballet Academy in Washington, D.C. She won Silver medal at the Dong–Ah completion in Korea.

She danced in numerous supporting and leading roles. After she married Kyudong Kwak, she joined Nevada Ballet Theatre and was promoted to principal dancer in 2003. Lee also selected as "Best Ballerina in 2014" for the Best of the City, Desert Companion magazine.

She is the Co-founder of Las Vegas ballet Company and stages in most of Las Vegas Ballet Company's repertoire. Lee's repertoire includes principal roles in Swan Lake, Giselle, Sleeping Beauty, Coppelia, Paquita, Shim-Chung (The blind man's daughter), Romeo and Juliet, The Nutcracker, Don Quixote, George Balanchine's Serenade, Allegro Briante, Who cares?, Theme and Variation and many others.

The Story

Act 1

The Nutcracker begins at the Stahlbaum home on Christmas Eve. Mr. and Mrs. Stahlbaum and their children Clara and Fritz are busy preparing for the evening festivities. The guests arrive, including Clara's Godfather, the magician, Herr Drosselmeyer. Drosselmeyer has fashioned a special gift for Clara, A Nutcracker designed in the form of a small soldier. Clara falls in love with her Nutcracker at once.

That night, Clara is unable to sleep without one more look at her Nutcracker. She tiptoes back into the living room and cradles her soldier once more before falling asleep. She is not sure if she is dreaming or not, but before her eyes are huge mice playing in front of the Christmas tree that has grown to a tremendous size. The Nutcracker fights with the Mouse King and, in the heat of the battle, Clara takes off her slipper and throws it at the Mouse King. While he is distracted, the Nutcracker stabs him with his saber.

After the battle, the Nutcracker is transformed into a handsome prince and, grateful to Clara for saving his life, invites her to accompany him on a journey to the fabled Kingdom of the Sugar Plum Fairy. En route, they pass through the exquisite land of the Snow Queen and her Prince and watch the magical dance of the snowflakes.

Act 2

It begins in the land of the Sugar Plum Fairy, where Clara is greeted by the Sugar Plum Fairy, her Cavalier and her entire court. She and her Nutcracker Prince tell the tale of their adventure, and they are rewarded with entertainment from an array of dances, including Spanish, Arabian, Chinese, Mirlitons, and Candy Cane dancers, as well as many Bon Bon children. A beautiful Waltz of the Flowers follows and the evening concludes with the grand pas de deux, performed by the Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier. Following the pas de deux, Clara is whisked away with her prince in a magical sled, while waving goodbye to the Sugar Plum Fairy and her magical kingdom. Clara awakens and wonders if is was real or all a dream?
